



JOB POSTING FLEET SUPERVISOR

Summary:

The Fisherman's Pride Fleet Supervisor will oversee the commercial and food fishery fleet. This person will also be responsible for coordinating the day-to-day operations of the fleet before, during and after the fishing season.

The Fleet Supervisor will be responsible for the following:

- Ensure cost effectiveness in managing all equipment/supplies.
- Oversee crew members, Organize and adjust vessel crews.
- Evaluate captains' performance on yearly basis.
- Ability to deal effectively with other business partners & crew members.
- Ensuring that the crew members are prepared for the commercial season.
- Ensure vessels meet safety requirements and advise captains on importance of health and safety in the workplace.
- Maintain accurate inventory of fishing supplies and assets.
- Coordinate pickup and delivery of supplies.
- Ability to take a teamwork approach to the job by cooperating with others.
- Monitor and keep track of any information pertaining to our vessels, equipment and buildings.
- Ensure vessels are serviced and maintained as required
- Attend vessels within the fleet on a regular basis to review/monitor the condition and performance of each vessel
- Participate in training and capacity development initiatives

Requirements:

Excellent knowledge of commercial fisheries
Excellent knowledge of marine safety
Required safety training certification, i.e. DVS, SVOP
Extensive knowledge of vessel maintenance
Good verbal and writing skills
Must possess a valid driver's license
Must be able to work a flexible schedule (evenings and weekends)
